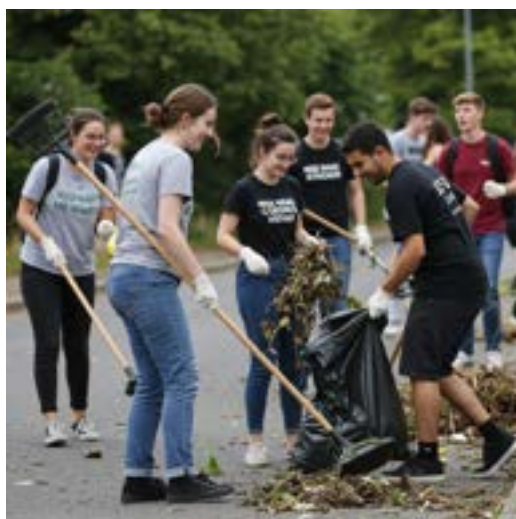

Exercises

1. Communication Origami

Materials Needed: Origami paper (preferably square-shaped), Blindfolds (one for each participant), A flat surface to work on

- Purpose of the activity: to test and improve your communication skills in a fun and interactive way.

→ Preparations (Game Rules):

Step 1: Pairing Up

Divide participants into pairs. Each pair will consist of a "Guide" and a "Folder."

The Guide will give verbal instructions for folding the origami, while the Folder will be blindfolded and remain silent.

2. Stand Up for Fillers:

The audience reaches out to anyone interested in interacting with the common artistic vision, regardless of residency. By employing simple tools to make virtual attractions accessible, the aim is to create an inclusive experience that transcends geographic boundaries and backgrounds.

How should it be promoted?

Collaboration will be established with regional cultural institutions to promote the project, utilizing their platforms and networks to spread awareness. Furthermore, to showcase the immersive experiences offered by the virtual art installations, both real-world metropolitan areas and virtual platforms will be utilized.

What tools are needed?

To bring the idea to life, an intuitive program will need to be created to blend virtual components into actual locations. Additionally, the approach will be tested and promoted by a committed group of individuals, ensuring its effective execution and broad acceptance.

In summary, the project encourages individuals to accept contemporary technology as a tool for group discovery and integration. By experiencing interesting aspects of urban surroundings, users may develop relationships, broaden perspectives, and be amazed at the combination of creativity and technology shaping the dynamic world.



Summarizing

The article highlights community arts initiatives that use a variety of artistic mediums, including painting, sculpture, theater, music, and dance, to allow locals to shape their surroundings.
